Directions: The park is located directly South of the San Diego Airport Terminal 2 (across Harbor Drive)

From Interstate-5 South:

Take The Airport exit and proceed down KETTNER BLVD - go 0.6 miles. Turn Right on W LAUREL ST - go 0.3 miles, it becomes N. HARBOR DR. Continue on N HARBOR DR - go 1.6 miles. Turn left into the park just past the airport exits. Look for a blue and white Itasca RV with a Su-Hi '64 banner!

From the Marriott (Convention Center):

Start out going Southeast on W. HARBOR DR. toward FRONT ST. 0.1 miles. Turn LEFT onto 1st AVE. 0.1 miles. Turn LEFT onto W. MARKET ST. 0.2 miles. Turn RIGHT onto W. HARBOR DR. 2.5 miles. Turn LEFT into the Park just past the airport exits. Look for a blue and white Itasca RV with a Su-Hi '64 banner!
